ESTIMATED FACTORY COST OF PRODUCING
AN UPDATED, FIELD GRADE
MODEL 32 O/U SHOTGUN

10,000 Guns/Year at \$350.00 Per Gun

The updated M/32 would be manufactured along the lines of our present shotguns with press checkering, roll marked frame, and standard walnut stock.

The cost estimate was based on the following parameters:

1. A volume of 10,000 units per year.
2. A proposed retail price of \$350.00 per unit.
3. The Over & Under Shotguns would be the same quality as our present shotgun lines.
4. The O/U Shotgun would be manufactured in 12 Gauge only.
5. The barrel cost estimate was calculated for a vent rib barrel.
6. The cost estimate was based on the last M/32 design (single trigger with selector).
7. The standard discounts were used to arrive at the net selling price.
