

COMPETITIVE ARMS EVALUATION

A sample Browning autoloading high power rifle was shown to the Committee. R & D presented a detailed comparison of appearance and function with the Remington Model 742 rifle. Two copies of the report will be issued. One is to be retained by R & D and the second placed in the permanent Operations Committee files.

After the review, those in attendance at the Operations Committee Meeting were instructed not to discuss the evaluation as the data are confidential and these studies are made only for General Management information and guidance.
