Marketing is not interested in using Corfam Sling Straps. Minimum cost for the sample submitted would be \$1.53 versus \$.68 for leather. Furthermore, neither the appearance of the single or double thickness of the Corfam is satisfactory.

Committee Action:

Continuing the present design of the Bolt Handle was approved.

MODEL 742-760 CENTER FIRE RIFLES

The recommendation had been made to add the 6mm caliber in the Model 742 "BDL" and Model 760 "ADL" and "BDL". Marketing asked the Committee to approve the addition of 6mm caliber in the Model 760 "ADL" for January 1969 announcement. Marketing forecast sales of 600 units in the first year, of which 500 would be additional business.

The dropping of the 223 caliber was discussed. It was originally added to provide a rifle for this cartridge which is now in the Varmint Model 700.

Committee Action:

The addition of the 6mm caliber in the Model 760 "ADL" grade was approved for 1969 announcement.

Marketing agreed to drop the 223 caliber from the Model 760 in 1969.

POSITION STOCK TARGET RIFLE
