

SHOTGUNS - contd.OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN - MODEL 3200, 12 GAUGE

Marketing had requested figures to determine the effect of seven, ten and fifteen thousand per year volume sales for the "order-of-magnitude" economics for the proposed Model 3200 Over and Under 12 gauge shotgun. These figures are shown in the attached Exhibit 4. Marketing indicated the yearly volume would be a minimum of seven thousand (7000) guns. Also there would be a minimal effect on other Remington Shotguns. The Over and Under business would result from a reduction in sales by competitors of import guns.

A second draft of the project to authorize the preliminary design phase of the program has been sent to Bridgeport for review. This must be completed before more accurate estimates of product cost and expenditure can be made.

R & D is continuing on the basic design within limits of funds provided in the current Research budget.

CENTER FIRE RIFLESMODEL 788, 308 AND 6MM CALIBERSMODEL 581 CLIP MAGAZINE LEFT HAND RIFLE

Production reported that Model 788 Bolt Bodies are being run on the first N/C operation. Receivers are ready for assembly to Barrels. Tooling problems have delayed pilot production. Rifle assembly should start the first part of December.

A sample Model 581 Clip Magazine left hand rifle was shown to the Committee. R & D pilot testing remains to be completed.

Committee Action:

Upon satisfactory completion of R & D testing of the Model 581 left hand rifle, General Management is to be requested to approve invoice shipment.

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
