PRODUCT RELIABILITY

Attached to the agenda was a summary report covering the procedure now in effect for Ilion manufacture of firearms to check product reliability. This report was reviewed by Production at the meeting and examples given as to how the program applied in specific instances.

This was followed by an informal review of the R & D design of new guns to meet safety and increased endurance requirements. From the Model 11-48 to date, the requirements have become more stringent and cover all facets of operation such as function and safety under adverse conditions.

Committee Action:

The production report was accepted and is to be made part of the Operations Committee records after Legal approval is received.

In order to have a record of the general requirements set up by R. & D for the development of new guns, a report is to be submitted for Operations Committee and Legal review. Data will then be available if needed.
