

CENTER FIRE RIFLES - contd.MODEL 742 AUTOLOADING CENTER FIRE RIFLE

The equipment to Teflon plate the Model 742 Bolt Carrier, Bolt Assembly and Action Bar has been installed. April 7, representatives from Du Pont approved the installation and process. Six (6) sample plated parts have been taken to the Marshall Laboratory for final acceptance. Production has started.

The "fact" tag will not be attached to rifles having Teflon plating produced in 1969. In 1970, the benefits of Teflon plating probably will be included in advertising and other promotional material.

Now that the equipment is in operation, it is planned to determine the effect on function by plating some parts of the Model 1100, 870 and 760 guns. Each will have to be evaluated.

MODEL 760 PUMP ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLE

A proposed change in the design of the Action Bar Lock for the Model 760 Pump Action Rifle was discussed. The possibility of making a similar change to the Model 870 Slide Action Shotgun was also reviewed.
