

SHOTGUNS - contd.WOOD PRESS FORMING - cont'd.Committee Action:

The proposed change to allow for the abrasive machining of the Model 1100 Grip Cap was approved.

MODEL 870 SHOTGUNS

Sample guns with the proposed scroll marking and a 12 gauge Stock with white line spacers for the grip and butt were presented at the meeting. The mismatch of the Recoil Pad and spacer with the wood has been reduced. ERD has indicated the match on the sample gun can be maintained when the automatic Remington machine is completed. This equipment should be in operation in June.

The estimated costs and earnings for the Model 870, 12-16-20 gauge to add roll marking to the Breech Bolt and white spacer to the butt and grip of the Stock plus the cost to add the roll marking to the 28 and 410 gauge are shown as Exhibit 1.

The difference in width of the butt and grip spacers was discussed.

Committee Action:

The addition of the butt and grip white spacers as presented on the prototype gun was approved for the Model 870, 12-16-20 gauge. General Management authorization to release to production was recommended. Announcement is scheduled January 1970.

Decorative roll marking of the Breech Bolts was not considered to be warranted at the present time.
