MODEL 870, 28-410 GAUGE MODEL 1100, 20-28-410 GAUGE - contd.

Committee Action:

R & D is to establish workable limits for the 410 gauge ammunition and gun .

Marketing will handle contacts with Federal.

The hardened insert is to be added to Model 1100, 28 and 410 gauge Receiver production. A satisfactory fastening process is to be established and costs developed. Equipment and blanks are to be expedited so that the change can be effected as soon as possible. Continued production of guns to the warehouse to the present design was authorized.

The specifications for the Model 1100, 20 gauge lightweight guns were approved as stated in the minutes.

MODEL 1100 AND 870 FALL AMERICAN" TRAP GUNE

R & D expects in the hear future to review sketches of proposed "All American" Model #100 and #70, 12 gauge with Marketing. The concept is to provide a gun in a price range of \$550 which would have c or D grade "robot" checkered wood. The Receiver, Barrel and Trigger Guard would have "robot" engraving. The equipment for engraving and checkering would be produced on an N/C machine, the prototype of which was reviewed by R & D at the March Operations Machine.

There would be no change to the basic guns except for an improvement to Trigger pull.
