

SHOTGUNS - contd.OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN

R & D reported that a prototype Over and Under 12 gauge shotgun should be completed for review in January 1970. This should include a review of the previously presented high spot economics.

Marketing reported that Browning is offering a single Barrel trap gun. R & D was requested to determine if the proposed Over and Under design could be used for a single Barrel gun. It is believed the appearance and balance might not be acceptable if the conversion could be made.

Regarding the use of XP shells in the proposed Model 3200, R & D has ordered one thousand (1000) rounds of ammunition and the shell specifications to determine what can be done to accommodate the proposed XP shell.

CENTER FIRE RIFLESTEFLON PLATING

Marketing reported for Committee information that one police department is having Model 870 parts Teflon plated by a vendor. The objective is to eliminate rusting when guns are carried in air conditioned automobiles.

MODEL 742-760 IMPROVED VERSION CENTER FIRE RIFLES

R & D reported that space available in the action due to larger Barrel for the magnum caliber required revisions to the gas system. Low initial acceleration of the action is required. It is believed that a piston action which is being developed will equal the jet action of the present Model 742. As soon as a satisfactory gas system has been developed, estimated rifle cost and expenditure can be estimated.

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
