The Committee approved the addition of the Model 870 and 1100, 34" Vent Rib Trap Barrel for introduction January 1971. General Management approval to release to production is to be requested.

MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" 12 GAUGE TRAP GUN
(Introduction 1971)

The prototype Model 870 "All American" 12 gauge Trap gun was reviewed by the Committee. The medallion has been repressed as recommended by Marketing. The proposed adhesive to fasten the medallion has been tested under adverse conditions and is satisfactory. 83

The economics are shown as Exhibit 3. A \$10.00 cost for a caddy case is included in the factory cost. Marketing should determine the specifications for the carrying case. Possibly another source could supply a more acceptable product.

Committee Action:

The Committee approved the proposed introduction of the Model 870, 12 gauge "All American" Trap gun January 1971. General Management approval to release to production is to be requested.

Marketing is to recommend the case to be used.
