

CENTER FIRE RIFLES - contd.MOHAWK 600 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE  
RIFLE TO REPLACE THE MODEL 660 - contd.

1. The Stock would be same as the Model 600 which was without Fore End Tip, Grip Cap and Spacer, Butt Plate Spacer and the Fore-Arm length reduced 1" for appearance. The finish would be lacquer.
2. The Barrel would be the same as the Model 660 magnum dimensions except an 18½" length and roll marked "Mohawk".
3. Barrel and Receiver finish would be the same as the Model 788.
4. Receiver would be marked "Mohawk".
5. The Trigger would be gold plated (Mohawk brand designation).

R & D tests indicated that the strength of a birch Stock would be satisfactory for the magnum calibers. Also epoxy bedding would not be required.

A prototype of the proposed Mohawk 600 in a 6.5mm Rem. Mag. caliber was shown to the Committee.

Costs are available so that Marketing can estimate annual sales and selling prices. The described changes are estimated to cost five thousand dollars (\$5000).

Committee Action:

Marketing is to review the proposal and the effect on the Bolt Action Center Fire line. Recommendations are to be made at the April meeting.
