Committee Action:

Marketing is to recommend continuance or dropping of the Rim Fire Target Rifle program at the April meeting.

NYLON 77 RIM FIRE CLIP MAGAZINE RIFLE
(Introduction 1970)

Production reported that assembly of Nylon 77 Clip Magazine Rim Fire Rifles started March 10, 1970. In addition to the changes required to the Stock mold, other component revisions were required. These are:

1. Ejector - Nylon 66 gallery rifle blanks are being altered for use in initial production.
2. Bolt - revised.
3. Clip Magazine - Revised for proper feeding in the Nylon 77. It had been planned to use the Model 581 Clip Magazine.

The production sample Nylon 77 Rim Fire Clip Magazine Rifle was reviewed by the Committee. Since there is a possibility that the Clip Magazine could be mixed between the Model 581 and Nylon 77 at the retail level, Marketing recommended that the Nylon 77 assembly be marked. This would also apply to the 10-shot Clip Magazine.
