MOHAWK 600 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE  
RIFLE TO REPLACE THE MODEL 660  
(Introduction 1971)

The prototype Mohawk 600 Center Fire Bolt Action rifle proposed as a replacement for the Model 660 was reviewed by the Committee.

The specifications would be the same as the Model 660 except -

1. The Stock would be the Model 600 which is without Fore End Tip, Grip Cap and Spacer, and the Butt Plate Spacer. The length of the forearm is reduced 1" to improve appearance. The regular Stock would be walnut and have a lacquer finish. The Stock for the magnum calibers will be birch with Recoil Pad.
