RIM FIRE RIFLES

RIM FIRE TARGET RIFLE

Marketing outlined a proposed program for rim fire target rifles and ammunition in a letter dated April 28, 1970. Copies were sent to all Operations Committee members.

R & D indicated approval of the program as outlined for target rifles.

Committee Action:

MODEL 391-592 5mm RIM FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLE (Introduction 1970)

R & D described a new Ejector design machined from bar stock. It will also have a retaining rivet to prevent any inadvertent disassembly. A Receiver Cover has been added to reinforce and seal the Ejector Cover. These changes should be adequate to withstand extreme pressures and be adaptable to alter existing rifles. It is also planned to replace Extractors with those having an improved heat treatment.

Production reported on the status of procurement of temporary tooling for the proposed Ejector changes so that assembly and repairs might be started the week of May 25. It is planned
