Caliber 17 Remington BDL Grade (Introduction 1971)

Drawings for this new caliber have also been released to the plant and tooling is being designed.

MOHAWK 600 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLE TO REPLACE THE MODEL 660 (Introduction 1971)

R & D resolved the Mohawk 600 Receiver marking with Marketing.

Model drawings will be transmitted to the plant. All other

drawings had previously been released. The design of the
tooling for the Stock, Barrel and Receiver will start in July.

Production reported that there are laminated blanks on hand to produce approximately two thousand (2000) Stocks. It was suggested that these be used for the 1971 production of the Mohawk 600 Magnum Stocks. However, Marketing indicated that only birch (walnut colored) should be used for the Mohawk 600 magnum rifle. Marketing will work out a special gun offering in order to use the laminated blanks. The value of the blanks is approximately eight thousand dollars (\$8,000).

RIM FIRE RIFLES

MODEL 591-592, 5mm RIM FIRE BOLT ACTION RIFLE (Introduction 1970)

Production reported that to date approximately two thousand (2000) Model 591-592 rifles have been returned from the field. About one thousand (1000) have been revised and re-shipped.

In addition to the returned rifles, approximately one hundred (100) of the warehouse rifles are being reworked each day. Steps are being taken on component production to increase the daily rate of repair and new rifle assembly.
