

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 1100 SHOTGUN - contd.

Marketing stated that five (5) of the areas to which chrome plated Pistons and Piston Seals had been sent have reported. The recommendation was made that to eliminate rusting, which is a problem particularly in the southern areas, these parts be plated. The estimated additional cost per gun is \$.16.

Committee Action:

General Management approval to chrome plate the Model 1100 Piston and Piston Seal was recommended.

MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" TRAP SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1972)

R & D reported that the "robot" metal engraving machine and fixtures would be completed for tryout the middle of October.

The design of the "robot" checkering machine and fixtures is scheduled to start in September 1970 and the machine should be ready for tryout September 1971.

The custom shop has experienced difficulty in obtaining sufficient hand checkered Stocks to fill orders. The possibility of using "robot" checkering is being investigated.

MODEL 3200 OVER AND UNDER SHOTGUN
(Introduction June 1972)

R & D reviewed the proposed program (Exhibit 3) for the Model 3200, 12 gauge over and under shotgun. This schedule indicates announcement January 1973.
