

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that the major problems in producing bench rest bullets seem to have been solved. Limited production is now available for Model 40XB production testing. Accuracy is excellent.

TRAPS

R & D reported that the one prototype trap has been assembled incorporating the cocking modifications. It is in operating condition and ready for Marketing review. The auto-angling cam does not produce a consistent change in the throwing angle. Further modifications are planned. These should be completed in November.

Marketing has to date been unsuccessful in obtaining additional data on the Swedish autoloading and auto-angling trap.

DISCONTINUANCE OF GUN SPECIFICATIONS FOR 1971

Marketing in a letter dated Aug. 19, 1970 (Exhibit 1) recommended, due to minimal sales, the discontinuance of fourteen (14) gun specifications in 1971. Marketing indicated there should be no loss in total gun sales volume.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee approved the discontinuance of fourteen (14) gun specifications as recommended by Marketing.
