

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 870, 12-20 GAUGE LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS  
(Introduction 1971)12 Gauge Left Hand Shotgun

R & D reported that the design confirmation testing of eight (8) pilot guns was satisfactory and production released.

Production reported that guns for field representatives should be produced in November. The production sample gun should be reviewed at the November meeting.

20 Gauge Left Hand Shotgun

Production reported that Barrels, Receivers and Breech Bolts required to pilot assemble Model 870, 20 gauge left hand shotguns should be completed in November. 83

MODEL 1100, 12-20 GAUGE LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS  
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that due to current production requirements, the decision has been made to delay pilot part manufacture of left hand Model 1100 Barrels and Breech Bolts until January 1971.

MODEL 870, 20 GAUGE LIGHTWEIGHT SHOTGUN  
(Introduction 1972)

R & D released the model drawings for the Model 870, 20 gauge lightweight shotgun. Processing and design of tooling has started.

MODEL 1100 SHOTGUN

Production reported that to date no skeet or trap Barrels having the reduced depth of the locking notch have been returned from the field with a cracked Barrel Extension.
