MODEL 870 "ALL AMERICAN" 12 GAUGE TRAP GUN - contd.

R & D reported that ten (10) sample gun cases to be provided by North American Rockwell will cost \$500.00. Sample case specifications are to be established and this program is to proceed. A minimum run of five thousand (5000) cases is required to obtain the price of approximately \$14.00 to \$15.00 per case.

Production reported that space requirements have been reviewed and it is indicated that by rearrangement, the following models can be produced in existing space at Ilion:

> Model 870 "All American" Trap Gun Model 1100 and 870, 12 Gauge 34" Trap Barrels Model 541S Sporter Bolt Action Clip Magazine Rim Fire Rifle

The review also indicates that the Over and Under Shotrun cannot be produced in existing space at Ilion even if the three, (3) models above are not produced.

The revised economics (Exhibit 1) including the costs for the proposed carrying case were reviewed.

The Operations Committee recommended General Management approval to release to production Model 870 "All American" 12 gauge trap guns.
