

CENTER FIRE RIFLES - contd.THE 742X RIFLE - AUTOLOADING CENTER FIRE - contd.

There was discussion regarding the logic of our numbering system for guns. It was recommended by Marketing to designate temporarily the autoloading center fire rifle under development as the Model 742X and the autoloading shotgun under development as the Model 1100X. New designations will be made for marketing the products.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee accepted the temporary designation of Model 742X and Model 1100X for the rifle and shotgun under development.

MODEL 700 BOLT ACTION CENTER FIRE RIFLE

Caliber 17 Rem.
(Introduction 1971)

Production reported that twenty-one hundred (2100) Model 700, caliber 17 Rem. rifles have been produced. It was recommended that reporting on this item be dropped.

Marketing reported that other manufacturers of rifles chambered for this round have been informed of the chamfer in the Firing Pin hole. A bulletin covering this chamfer will be sent to gunsmiths. R & D will discuss the chamfer of the Firing Pin hole at the next SAAMI Technical Committee Meeting.

Committee Action:

Reporting on the Model 700, caliber 17 Rem. will be dropped.

MOHAWK 600 BOLT ACTION CENTER
FIRE RIFLE TO REPLACE MODEL 660
(Introduction 1971)

Production reported that three thousand (3000) Mohawk 600 rifles have been produced. It was recommended that reporting on this item be dropped.
