MODEL 1100, 12-20 GAUGE LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported the first pilot lot of Model 1100, 12 gauge left hand shotguns was assembled and tested. The Interceptor Latch Spring disengaged from the Interceptor Latch on some guns.

A second pilot lot of guns has been assembled. These guns have been tested and inspected and will be submitted today to R & D for design confirmation testing.

Pilot parts have been completed for Model 1100, 20 gauge left hand shotguns. Pilot assembly has started.
