

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 1100, 12-20 GAUGE LEFT HAND SHOTGUNS
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that Model 1100, 12 gauge left hand shotguns are scheduled for manufacture late in the fourth quarter 1971.

Trial and pilot production of 12 gauge magnum left hand guns is scheduled for September.

Design confirmation testing of Model 1100, 20 gauge left hand shotguns revealed a malfunction rate of 0% to 1.66% with five guns being 1% or over. Approximately 50% of the malfunctions were "stem chamber - left." Carrier design is being reviewed.

MODEL 870, 20 GAUGE LIGHTWEIGHT SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1972)

Production reported that design confirmation testing of Model 870, 20 gauge lightweight shotguns showed the shooting functional performance to be satisfactory. A slight drag in the action is being corrected with new Fore-end Tube Assemblies. The point of impact was slightly low for targeting and this is being corrected with a revised Front Sight Base.

A production sample gun was presented for review.
