making this a 5/8 ounce load with a maximum loaded length of 2.715". In discussing competitive 410 gauge 3" ammunition, it was agreed that those manufacturers should be informed of the capability of this gun.

Production reported that extensive testing of 410 gauge 3" chamber shotguns with the new regular production ammunition has demonstrated that the performance is acceptable when guns are fired from the shoulder. Production was released to resume manufacturing using the revised Extractor.

LAW ENFORCEMENT GUN STOCK
(Introduction 1971)

The Chairman asked if everyone had seen the memo of July 6, 1971 - Proposal for Marketing Law Enforcement Gun Stocks. Economics were presented - Exhibit 2.

R & D reported that the design review of the Stock had been completed and a report issued. Marketing has discussed this report with The Belmore-Johnson Tool Company and necessary design revisions will be made.

Marketing reported that several additional law enforcement agencies have shown interest in purchasing this Stock. Marketing recommended that the plan to market this Stock be accepted.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee accepted the proposal for marketing law enforcement gun Stocks to be produced by The Belmore-Johnson Tool Company, Hamden, Conn. General Management approval to release this Stock for production was recommended.
