6.5 Rem. Mag. will be out of production in 1971 but will be in the 1972 catalog. Model 700 left hand rifle is being introduced in BDL grade, calibers 270, 30-06 and 7mm mag.

Marketing would consider dropping the XP-100 long range pistol. The economics are to be reviewed.

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that testing and packing of the warehouse quantity of 110M is essentially complete. Difficulty was experienced with the test barrel wearing out during the testing of these lots. A new barrel has been assembled which should allow us to continue.

Marketing reported that it is planned to introduce this bullet at the Outdoor Writer's Seminar in November.

TRAPSELECTRIC TOURNAMENT TRAP

R & D reported that quotations have been received for manufacturing the template trap. North American Rockwell quoted a price of \$1080 per trap in quantities of 750. The tool charge will be \$14,255; pattern charge, \$3840. The price for the trap magazine attachment was \$315 each for a quantity of 750. Tooling would be \$2645 and patterns, \$1785. MacLaw Tool and Aircraft Parts quoted \$866 each for a quantity of 500. Tooling is amortized in the piece price and the pattern charge would be \$4255.

Marketing reported that the Winchester tournament trap sells for \$561 to the distributor and \$610 to gun clubs. The total market for hand fed traps is estimated to be 1500 to 2000 per year. With an acceptable trap, Remington should get 50% of
