We have been requested by Management to be extremely selective in accepting and processing orders for the folding stock and magazine extension because of the decided advantage these accessories could give if acquired for unlawful purposes.

Therefore, we ask that the Parts Department establish the following procedures:

1. Accept folding stock orders only from wholesalers who have signed and returned the enclosed statement on resale "to recognized law enforcement and military agencies". (A form letter is enclosed for use when wholesalers neglect to submit the signed statement either before or with their initial orders.) We anticipate that there will be very few wholesalers who will not return their signed statements to you promptly.
2. Fill orders for folding stocks and magazine extensions from our wholesalers and from recognized federal, state and city agencies only. Do not accept personal orders from individuals, even when submitted on official stationery, when the shipping address is other than that of a recognized law enforcement agency. (A second form letter is enclosed for your use in replying to those who place such orders.)

Your cooperation in adhering to the above procedures will be very much appreciated.
