MODEL 742-X RIFLE - AUTOLOADING CENTER FIRE - contd.

It is expected that the magnum rifle will weigh 7 lbs., 13 oz.

In discussing the introduction of both the new shotguns and rifles in this family, Marketing indicated that it must be a rolling introduction (see Semi-Annual Firearms Development Schedule - October, 1972.)

Production reported that the long range forecast from Marketing is being used as basic data for the facilities studies. It is indicated that rearrangement in existing buildings and construction of new buildings will have to start in 1973. A project for this work will be submitted in early 1973.

The Chairman stated that facilities planning must not assume that the gun introduction schedules cannot be changed. This facilities planning should propose alternatives and be a part of the input to the overall schedule for this new gun program.

The possibility of obsoleted models being made in Brazil was discussed briefly.

Production reported that wanagement approval to release for favoice shipment has been requested.

MODEL 700 EMPROVEMENTS Lintroduction 1974)

Several changes were required and revised economics were completed after the meeting. These are included here as Exhibit 5, First Year 1974; Exhibit 6, Third Year 1976, and Exhibit 7, Third Year 1976 at Reduced Volume.
