R & D reported that both the grip and Fore-end checkering patterns have been run and produced satisfactorily.

A variety of Stocks, including the Model 541-S, are being checkered by a vendor in New Hampshire. Plant employees are being trained in the use of the hand operated hand checkering tools.

Proposed volume, selling price and costs of the position rifles was reviewed - Exhibits 3 & 4. In discussing the proposed rifles, it was indicated that essentially the only change would be new Stocks. It is believed that this is what is required to make the target rifles more acceptable. The economics are to be completed as soon as possible so that a decision can be made upon project submission.

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that trouble with gilding material is still holding up production. The latest lot will not go through blank and cut without excessive pickup on punch and dies. Action is being taken to provide a minimum of three lots in inventory which have been sampled and proven.

There are back orders for 700,000 bullets.
