Development of the Model 742 X is on schedule. Four prototype rifles will be completed in July: two magnum and two 30-06 with 243 and 25-06 interchangeable Barrels. These rifles will be available for Marketing field testing. Ten additional pratotype rifles will be completed in March, 1974. These will be used to determine interchangeability of component and for final testing before release of design in June, 1974.

It is expected that Barrel Assemblies will be interchangeable without factory fitting.
