Production reported that Sycamore wood for these target rifles has been ordered. A Plant Order for the tooling is to be prepared.

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that new material from Anaconda and Bridgeport Brass is satisfactory. Both vendors now believe they can continue to produce acceptable material. It is not yet possible to write specifications that will assure the material will be acceptable.

By June 1, the second 100,000 bullets will be completed from this new material.

TRAPS

ELECTRIC TOURNAMENT TRAP
(Introduction 1973)

R & D reported that the Teflon[®] pad, upon which the targets fall, warps too much and causes unpredictable flight of the targets. This is being replaced with heat treated aluminum. Parts for 100 traps have been received.

Marketing reported that the problems encountered in field testing have been corrected. Overall reaction to the traps in field testing is favorable. It is planned to announce July 1 and begin shipments in August.

REMINGTON SKEET TRAP

Marketing expects to request R & D to design a skeet trap based upon the tournament trap. It is believed that this product can be justified on a break-even basis.

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
