

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 3200 ONE OF 1000 SKEET SHOTGUN - contd.

Using the One of 1000 trap gun as a base, four of those engraving patterns are being modified and two are being replaced with new patterns. A prototype gun should be available for the July meeting.

MODEL 3200 FIELD MAGNUM SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1974)

Production reported that tooling for the Model 3200 field magnum shotgun has been ordered with delivery expected in August.

IRON SHOT PROGRAM

Production reported that estimates are being prepared for producing Model 3200 shotgun Barrel Assemblies with the larger outside diameter at the muzzle of the Barrel. The Barrel will have a long taper to the increased diameter.

The Acting Chairman reported that iron shot is becoming a broader program. Fifteen states are now involved. There is a lack of uniformity among the plans of the different states which could lead to a federally guided program.

ADHESIVE-FASTENED VENT RIB AND PHOTO-ETCHED MATTING

Production reported that the cause of non-uniform application of resist coating on the Barrel Assembly for photo-etched matting has been determined. Production equipment is being modified to correct this condition. It is estimated that production startup of this process will be in August, 1973.

Work on adhesive Vent Rib bonding is deferred pending startup of the photo-etch process.

MODEL 1100 AUTOLOADING SHOTGUN - SHELL CATCHER

R & D reported that T & S Industries, Inc. has quoted a price for their shell catcher of \$2.60 each in lots of 5,000 or \$2.55 each in lots of 10,000. Delivery at the rate of 1000 per week would start 2 weeks after receipt of order.
