

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 3200 SHOTGUN - contd.

Marketing requested that a Recoil Pad be added to the skeet gun for 1974.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee accepted Marketing's recommendation to add a Recoil Pad to the skeet gun for 1974.

MODEL 3200 ONE OF 1000 SKEET SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1974)

R & D reported that N/C programming of the new engraving and checkering patterns for the One of 1000 skeet gun is being held. A Management decision is needed on whether or not the patterns will be the same as the One of 1000 trap guns.

MODEL 3200 FIELD MAGNUM SHOTGUN
(Introduction 1974)

Production reported it is estimated that tooling for the thicker wall Barrels for the Model 3200 field magnum shotgun will cost \$30,100. The factory cost will be \$3.04 greater than the standard field gun - \$.71 for Barrels and \$2.33 for Recoil Pad.

Marketing indicated that shipment in the third quarter 1974 would be required for 1974 introduction. Barrels suitable for iron shot are required.

Production is to provide schedule to Marketing by October 5 so that a decision can be made on introduction date.

MODEL 3200 TRAP 32" VENT RIB BARREL
(Introduction 1975)

R & D presented a prototype Model 3200 shotgun with 32" Vent Rib Barrels. This gun is approximately 12 ounces heavier than the 30" Barrel gun.
