Examination has been completed on the Model 600
 Rem-Com submachine gun, serial number 1212, which
 was returned to us because of the accidental firing
 upon examination.

The returned firearm, which was produced in
 September of 1967, has been thoroughly examined. Our
 own firm has advised its report that the needed
 modifications had been performed on the gun as
 evidenced by the letter "B" stamped on the upper
 left side of the trigger.

The general condition of the rifle appears to be
 good, but the stock contains numerous scratches
 and marks. In addition it was noted that a
 large hole had been drilled into the stock near
 the trigger guard. It was also noted that the
 trigger guard was not properly secured.
