

BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that production of bench rest bullets in 1974 is at better than break-even on cost. A minimum of 10,000 per day is the production goal. 382M were produced in January and February.

Marketing reported that price of the bullet will be increased April 1.

TRAPSELECTRIC TOURNAMENT TRAP
(Introduction 1973)

R & D reported that 39 electric tournament traps have been sold. Thirteen traps are on consignment making a total of 52 in the field. It was recommended that this item be removed from the agenda.

Marketing is to make a report on field performance at the April meeting. The Operations Committee will consider dropping reporting at that time.

REMINGTON SKEET TRAP
(Introduction 1975)

R & D reported that development is continuing on the high house feed system to obtain better accuracy.

Development time plus delivery time on castings indicates that announcement will be delayed beyond January, 1975.

Marketing indicated the trap is needed to provide complete equipment for clubs. Announcement is not tied to January 1.

It was agreed that announcement in June, 1975 would be shown on the Firearms Development Schedule.
