## SUMMARY:

The Remington loading system is slightly preferred to the Browning.

The Winchester Super X1 is definitely rated as least preferred.

## COMMENT:

Browning - Opinion is sharply divided on merits of the self-feeding capability of the Browning design. Unlike the functionally similar system used with the earlier Browning "double automatic" circa 1965, the present Browning loading system has the potential to inflict painful injury to the fingers.

Winchester - The Winchester loading system is not liked. Inadvertent release of the carrier to the downward position during the loading sequence interferes with insertion of additional shells into the magazine.
