Browning remains consistent with their previous "hump-back" designs.

Winchester is reminiscent of the Model 12 receiver area with some manufacturing concessions in the trigger guard.

SUPER X1 - MODEL 12 WINCHESTER SIMILARITY

Winchester has succeeded in locating the balance point (center of gravity) of their new autoloader very close to that of their Model 12. This is relatively far to the rear for a gas operated autoloader. Their fore end length is shorter than the M/1100.

MAGAZINE UNLOADING

All three shotguns can be unloaded without manually cycling the shells in the magazine through the chambering sequence. Both Browning and Winchester instruction folders provide instructions on how to do this. The Remington instruction folder details the magazine unloading sequence via complete cycling only. The carrier release must be manually tripped at this time.

Browning claims as to ease of unloading and shell substitution are justified.
