Missouri Valley Walnut Co.

- (1) Production of stocks from gun stock logs will average 50,000 short stocks and 11,000 M/700 stocks per month.
- (2) Using veneer logs, with an increase in cost of 25%, the production yield will be greater and planning production schedule can be met. Total annual increase in procurement cost would be \$787,900.00
- (3) Delivery of stocks, using veneer logs, on short stocks would be January 1975 and M/700 stocks in February 1975.
- (4) Ordered from Missouri-Valley Walnut Co., 30,000 short stocks at \$3.43 each and 12,000 M/700 stocks at \$9.22 each. Both stocks will be made from veneer logs. Delivery on short stocks will be late December or early January and M/700 long stocks in February.

Midwest Gun Stocks, Inc.

- (1) This Company can deliver 20,000 short stocks per month starting in January 1975 at \$2.40 each.
- (2) They can deliver 3,000 M/700 long stocks per month starting in May 1975 at \$7.30 each.
- (3) Delivery of Fore-ends will start in January 1975: 10" length 78¢ ea; 12½" length 94¢ each and 14" length \$1.10 each.
- (4) Order 120,000 short stocks and fore-ends for delivery 20,000 per month starting January 1975.
