- . It is planned to submit a project now for 1976. The \$13,655,000 expenditures, Exhibit 4, will be reduced by removing buildings and long delivery items from this project. This will be followed by a 1977 project for buildings and long delivery items.
- . Any change in the 5-Year Forecast will change the proposed projects.
- It is too late to provide additional equipment for 1975
- Delivery time may decrease over the next few months.
