

SHOTGUNS - contd.MODEL 3200 COMPETITION SKEET AND TRAP SHOTGUN - contd.

At the field sales meeting, the general feeling was that the proposed guns were not of significantly greater value than the Special Trap grade gun. Higher grade wood is desirable; however, Production has no source of anything above B grade wood for the proposed volume.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee agreed to delay introduction of the Competition Grade Skeet and Trap shotguns until January, 1976. Marketing is to complete a financial appraisal of the product for review at the January meeting.

MODEL 3200 SINGLE BARREL TRAP SHOTGUN

(Introduction January, 1977 - revised from June, 1976)

R & D reported there has been no work on this product during the previous month. As reported in November, 1974, introduction will be delayed to January, 1977.

Committee Action:

The Operations Committee agreed to change the introduction date to January, 1977 for the single Barrel Trap shotgun.

MODEL 3200, 20, 28 AND 410 GAUGE SKEET BARREL SETS

(Introduction June, 1976)

R & D presented a prototype 410 gauge skeet Barrel set which was interchangeable with a 12 gauge Barrel set. The 20 and 28 gauge Barrel set prototypes are being completed. Since the 410-12 gauge combination represents the extreme in appearance, release to production was recommended based upon these prototypes.
