

M/742 - M/760 - NEW GENERATIONFOR ANNOUNCEMENT 1977-78

The New Generation M/742 and M/760 proposed for announcement in 1977 and 1978 will feature all new styling and significant engineering improvements.

FIRST CHART

This chart is a summary of the New Generation Program for 1977-78.

Basically, all of the mechanical improvements will be made in both the ADL and BDL models for the M/742 and M/760 in January 1977. At this same time, the styling of the BDL models of the M/742-760 will also be changed.

So (referring to chart), in 1977 for the M/742-760 BDL models, we propose new features in the styling of the fore end, receiver, buttstock, with a number of design changes to improve the mechanics of the gun. These changes serve to smooth the function of the gun, provide better reliability, improve safety and give the shooter greater endurance. I'll review the specifics of these design changes in a moment.

For announcement in 1978, the M/742-760 ADL models will undergo a complete styling change, including a new contour in the fore end and buttstock and alteration of the receiver roll-marking. The restyling of the ADL series will not affect our processes; that is, the buttstock and fore end will continue to be press-checked and the receiver will continue to be roll-marked. As mentioned, the design improvements will be made for both the ADL and BDL models in 1977.
