

6. All 1975 product improvements will be incorporated in the New Generation M/1100 shotgun.
7. The new buffer system will decrease the impact loads, thus increasing endurance life to the receiver and action components.

Basically, the M/870 New Generation, for announcement in 1979, will feature the same type of styling and engineering changes as the M/1100 will have in 1978. These improvements will include:

1. Redesigned pressed checkering patterns for both the stock and fore end.
2. The new feed latch retainer system, which does not require the special staking tool, for both the right and left shell latches.
3. The improved fire control, with one piece connector with special wide trigger.

The Skeet and Trap models of the 870 will feature cut checkering on stock and fore end, the special nonglare matte finish on the top of the receiver, and receiver markings somewhat different than at present. The M/870 Trap gun will also feature the M/3200 style of special ventilated rib.

In all respects, the New Generation M/1100 and M/870 will feature advances in styling and engineering which will distinguish the new generation from our present models.

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
