MODEL 788 IMPROVEMENTS

R & D reported they have a proposed design to stop Bolt Handles from coming off. This design is being tested:

- . Determine unlocking loads of high pressure handloads.
- . Static load Bolt Handle to failure.
- . Dynamic load Bolt Handle to failure.

This test data will be compared to similar information for the current product design.

BICENTENNIAL MODELS
(Introduction 1976)

The Bicentennial Committee reported that the objective was to have a program that would reflect well on Remington while recognizing this 200th Anniversary of our country. The program should be reasonably profitable but not profiteering.

Marketing reported that a program to include an eagle motif on the left side of the Receiver of Models 870, 1100, 742, 760 and Nylon 66 has been proposed. It is expected that 40,000 total guns will be sold with 40% of this as plus business. It was reemphasized that this program was to be a gesture recognizing the anniversary. A prototype Model 1100 shotgun was presented with the recommendation that this program be accepted. Consideration is being given to making a commemorative print available to customers who purchase these special guns.
