BENCH REST BULLETS

R & D reported that 1,054,000 bullets have been produced in 1975 through May. Sales value is \$59,000, factory cost \$45,000 and factory profit 24%. There are approximately 1,000,000 bullets in the warehouse.

The possibility of introducing another caliber bullet is being investigated.

Marketing was requested to review the sales, cost and warehouse position of the present bullet.

TRAPS

<u>NEW MECHANICAL TRAP</u> (Introduction October, 1975)

R & D reported that the mechanical trap is being redesigned. The cocking lever is being repositioned to the fear of the trap and a throwing arm perimeter guard is being added. This trap is being compared with the following foreign and our own traps: Rossini, Hansen, Paserli and Blue Rock. Three prototype traps will be available in October, not production traps. A presentation of this program is planned for the June Operations Committee Meeting.

Field evaluation will start in June. With the exception of some electrical parts, all other parts are ready for assembly.
