

normal firing position. For all of these reasons, the chance of a similar accident and injury happening to a shooter in the field is infinitesimal.

COMMITTEE ACTION

The committee directed discontinuance of the use of the new source powder for the powder metal cocking pieces and reversion to the old source powder as was used in production prior to September 1970. Recall of rifles made with the new source powder was considered unnecessary because of the negligible possibility of the accident and injury occurring in the field.
