Matter under discussion was 280 Remington Loaded Rounds with 270 Case Mix.

A.J. Hermandorfer briefed the Subcommittee concerning the 280 caliber product problem that was first discovered at Ilion. Initial testing indicated that all of the suspect product loading was confined to the 9th and 10th of July, 1975, and that said product was never commercially distributed.

The Subcommittee, based upon this report which was subsequently confirmed by the final report attached hereto as Exhibit A, determined no further action was necessary.
