Attached is a copy of L. D. Presnell's final report on the subject.

He estimates 20M rounds were coded "LU03ID", which was the only code showing a powder mix.

We had returned to us 3179 rounds, thus accounting for approximately 15%. Of the "03" code returned not involved in specific complaints, 39% contained mixed powder.

Assuming that possibly 50% of the "03" code shipped were fired this past season, it looks like there could be some 8-10M rounds still in shooters' stocks.
