30-06 HIGH PRESSURE LOADS

Thirty wholesalers were checked to determine whether they had any suspect 30-06 ammunition produced on or near the date of the product known to have some high-pressure rounds. One wholesaler was found to have 10,000 rounds of code K22D, loaded the day after the problem code. This ammunition is being returned and will be tested on arrival.

300 rounds of the suspect ammunition have been sent to the Olin St. Marks plant for examination.

Fifty rounds of 17 cal. ammunition loaded with the same powder have been tested to date. All were within pressure specification. Testing of this code will continue.

No customer complaints have been received.
