

to be contained within the receiver, so that there is no risk of personal injury.

The Subcommittee concluded that there was no significant safety hazard. Nevertheless, it was recommended that the 7mm Express Remington ammunition in question be recalled because it could cause damage to certain firearms. As for other calibers loaded with the same lot of mixed powder, no recall is necessary because pressures generated are within specifications. The Subcommittee released the hold that had been placed on such ammunition in the warehouse.

A program for conducting a recall of the ammunition in question will be considered at the next meeting of the Subcommittee. (Secretary's notes: Subsequent to the meeting, the President approved the Subcommittee's recommendation to recall 7mm Express Remington ammunition with codes M02I, M03I, M07I, M08I, M09I, and M13I.)
