Customer Service reported that 96,669 cartridges and fired cases have been returned, of 261,000 cartridges shipped, in response to the recall of ammunition codes in which mixed powder was suspected.

M3200 Recall

Marketing reported on the status of the recall of Model 3200 guns and replacement hammers. They reported that all of the hammers purchased as parts have been removed from service and that 120 guns, representing 39% of the total, have been returned for correction. Marketing plans a further recall effort in March, 1981, when a second registered mail message will be sent. Results of the recall will then be reported.
