

Clay Target Package Warnings

Product and Field Service presented a sample clay target box with new warnings on target usage printed on the top outside flap.

There was discussion on the warning message.

After discussion, the Subcommittee approved modified warning language (See Attachment A).

Warnings are to appear on clay target boxes as soon as possible.

6mm Recall

As of October 27, 1983, 52,760 rounds or 10.8% of recalled ammunition has been returned. Most of this ammunition has been from wholesalers. Consumer returns should pick up when the recall notices appear in December-January vertical publications.

Rifled Slug Recall

As of October 27, 1983, 47 customers have returned 1,752 rounds or 4.6% of recalled slugs. Customer response to this recall was heavy last month.

Model Seven Update

To date 78.3% or 1,840 Model Seven's have been updated. Four hundred seventy-one of the rifles that still need to be updated are being held by dealers or consumers.

In early November, phone calls to dealers and consumers will again be initiated in Remington's effort to meet the 100% update objective.

On November 1, 1983 a second letter was sent to Remington Warranty Gunsmiths requesting completion of warranty forms. This effort will provide further progress towards the 100% objective.
