I have used a black permanent marker to draw a border around all dents & creases which I would consider substantial enough to be noteworthy. Since you are going to get the box back & you can see my markings for yourself, I will not try to give a lengthy written description here.

I would suspect the contents are not damaged based on the boxes exterior damage generated on this leg of the shipment provided the interior is properly designed to protect the contents.

The gun is on it's way back to you via UPS ground.
